A poor explanation Here's a lesson in medical errors: when a doctor speaks in an unclear or contradictory way about something he knows about, you don't need a medical degree to understand that he's blowing smoke. That's why it's so dangerous to have someone prescribing a medication who doesn't understand the mechanism of action of a drug. For example, a patient who's trying to get off opiates often wants to try Suboxone first. When the drug's manufacturer recommends Suboxone, that's a good thing to do. But some patients taking Suboxone mistakenly believe they need to take the drug with a shot of naloxone first to block the naloxone and prevent the effect of the Suboxone. Worse yet, they believe that if they take naloxone alone, they'll have a normal opioid experience. Why is the combination called Suboxone? The manufacturer, B.S.N., created Suboxone in 1997, and even named it after an ancient form of speed. The root of the name, sub, is derived from Subutilos — a derivative of "subtract," another form of speed. The drug has morphine in it, but it also has naloxone — often called "N's" by drug abusers. In 1999, Suboxone was approved by the FDA to treat alcohol dependence and opioid dependence. Suboxone functions by slowly eliminating the brain's receptors for opiates. Opioids like heroin, Oxycontin, Oxycodone, and fentanyl cause the same effect when they reach the brain. Note: If you're using Suboxone for a different reason, like anxiety, then it's possible for the drug to have a powerful positive effect, especially if you're already abusing opioids like heroin. Suboxone was originally prescribed as a way to wean people off opiates without replacing the opioids. But now you can get Suboxone in a blister pack that contains both the medication and a needle. That way, you get both the drug and the needle in one shot. Although addiction specialists have recommended
